Notice of Court Case Procedure

The Court case will proceed as follows:

1. Jury members are to call in to the conference call at 11am Sydney time Sunday 27th of April.

You can dial in via a landline or via an internet calling facility. If you dial in via a mobile phone you will be charged mobile phone rates for the periods of the calls.

You dial the toll free number or the local number as you wish. If you live in the city where the local number is then please use the local number. You will be charged local call fees only for your calls.

Once you have dialed in you press these numbers on your touchpad. This is my assigned number for all conference calls for MBA.

When I dial into the conference call I will enter the administrators code and that will start the conference call. You will be on hold until I enter the administrators code.

You can test this facility any time. When you test it you should reach a conferencing message that tells you that you are connected but no conference is taking place.

I recommend you test this number on your handset of skype before Sunday 11am.

We have found the linux version of skype has "call phones and SMS" at the bottom right hand corner for those of you who have linux.

If you wish to not use your voice on the call because it is being recorded you can send your comments to the secretary on skype IM. The secretary can repeat your comments to the jury. His skype address is "calmarake". You will have to identify yourself by name and by jury member number before he will respond to you.

We assume our friends at ASIO are going to try and infiltrate the jury. We have already removed one man who claimed he wanted to be on the jury because he would not provide me with any evidence of who he was.

Features of the conference software on the phone are as follows:

Conferencing Features

Your onConference account gives you access to a rich set of security and convenience features. Access them by entering these codes during your conference call:

For most of the time all 12 jury members will have your lines muted so no background noise comes into the conference call. So *6 and *7 are the two key commands to remember for jury members.

2. The secretary will administer the word giving/oath taking as the man prefers. There are two different approaches we recommend. You either give your word or you make oath as you see fit.

The secretary will ask you:

“Under what bond do you agree to be a jury member?”

Suggested answers are:

“I give my word that I will try this case justly and fairly under the law of “do unto others”. I will try this case exactly as I would wish to be treated were I the accused or the accuser. I do this under penalty of perjury.”

“I make oath that I will try this case justly and fairly under the law of “do unto others”. I will try this case exactly as I would wish to be treated were I the accused or the accuser. I do this under penalty of perjury.”

If you wish to say something different please bring that to the secretary BEFORE the meeting on mbalssecretary01@mensbusinessassociation.com.

The secretary will then ask you two questions:

“By your word/oath are you a member of a secret society?”

“By your word/oath are you any form of agent here to subvert this process?”

The penalty for a false answer at this stage will then be perjury.

You are required to answer no to be on the jury. If you answer yes you will not be allowed on the jury.

Once you have finished the process of your word/oath giving you can hang up and wait until the jury trial proper starts at 12 midday to call back in.

3. At 12 midday the jury trial will begin. You will call back in and we will wait for all 12 jury members to call in to the conference call.

Should Chris Merrett not call in the jury trial will proceed without a defense being presented.

The Secretary will say:

"Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are gathered here today to perform a jury trial of one Chris Merrett who has been accused under oath and penalty of perjury of the crime of slander against one Peter-Andrew: Nolan@.

The Jury has been brought to the Jury Trial under their word or their oath that they feel is sufficient to bond them to perform a fair and just process as a jury member under the law of "do unto others as you would have them do unto you.

If any member of the Jury has any objection to performing the role he has agreed to perform speak now or forever hold your piece.

Let the Jury trial begin. "

If Chris Merrett is on the call the Secretary will say:

"Chris Merrett. How do you plead to the accusation that you have committed the crime of which you have been accused?"

If Chris Merrett is not on the call the Secretary will say:

"The man calling himself Chris Merrett has had fair notice that this Jury Trial will be taking place. He has chosen not to be present as is his right. The Jury Trial will proceed without a defense. Each member of the Jury must satisfy himself that Chris Merrett has committed the crime of which he has been accused based on the evidence that will be presented to you. The decision must be unanimous."

If Chris Merret pleads guilty the Secretary will say:

"The accuser has set the price of remedy at AUD100,000. Are you willing to agree here, under your word and penalty of perjury, that you will pay this remedy?"

If agreed then we can all go back to our busy schedules.

If Chris Merrett pleads innocent the Secretary will say:

"Then we will put the question of guilt or innocence to the jury of 12 honest men of honour and integrity. A unanimous decision of guilt will see you declared guilty. A dissenting vote will see you declared innocent."

If Chris Merrett pleads guilty but does not agree to the AUD100,000 fee the Secretary will say:

"Then we will put the question of the remedy fee to the jury of 12 honest men of honour and integrity. A unanimous decision is required on the amount of the remedy fee. The fee may be varied up or down by the Jury as they see fit. Costs of these deliberations will be paid for by Chris Merrett."

If Chris Merrett pleads innocent the Secretary will then say:

"We will first hear testimony from the accuser, Peter-Andrew: Nolan@.

In order to save the cost of the conference facility for the one hour it takes for a jury member to listen to the video presentation of this evidence or read the linked evidence the court will break for one hour while the Jury retires to listen to the video recording of the accusers evidence or to read the documentation of the accusers evidence.

This evidence is available on these links. The court is adjourned and the jury is retired. We will reconvene one hour from now."

4. When the court reconvenes the Secretary will then say:

"We will next hear testimony from the accused, the man calling himself Chris Merrett."

If no affidavit of response has been forthcoming then the secretary will say:

"Chris Merrett has had ample opportunity to submit to this court an Affidavit of Response. More than a year in fact. He has chosen not to do so. On this basis you, the Jury, must consider all statements made in the Affidavit of Accusation to be true at law.

Now, Chris Merrett will be given his chance to speak and to explain himself to his jury of his peers."

If an affidavit of response HAS been forthcoming then the secretary will say:

In order to save the cost of the conference facility for the time it takes for a jury member to listen to the video presentation of this evidence or read the linked evidence the court will break for xxxxx minutes while the Jury retires to listen to the video recording of the accusers evidence or to read the documentation of the accusers evidence.

This evidence is available on these links. The court is adjourned and the jury is retired. We will reconvene xxxxx minutes from now."

As yet no Affidavit of Response has been provided by Chris Merrett. It is due by 12 midday Saturday 26th of May.

5. When the court reconvenes the Secretary will say:

"To the foreman of the Jury are there any questions you or your jury members would like to ask of the accuser?"

The questions will be passed by the jury members to the secretary and back to the foreman via Skype IM. Any Jury member who wishes to ask a question may do so. He is warned that his voice will be recorded and the record will be placed into the public. So if a jury member wishes to be anonymous then he should use text IM or disguise his voice to an extent it will not be recognizable.

Once all questions to the accuser are exhausted then the Secretary will say:

"To the foreman of the Jury are there any questions you or your jury members would like to ask of the accused?"

The questions will be passed by the jury members to the secretary and back to the foreman via Skype IM. Any Jury member who wishes to ask a question may do so. He is warned that his voice will be recorded and the record will be placed into the public. So if a jury member wishes to be anonymous then he should use text IM or disguise his voice to an extent it will not be recognizable.

Once the questioning is over there will be one last chance to ask questions.

"To the foreman of the Jury are there any questions you or your jury members would like to ask of either party before retiring to discuss your verdict?"

If there are no more questions the forman will say:

"The jury will now retire to consider it's verdict. The discussion of the verdict will be recorded but it will be kept in confidence. Jury members may talk during the jury deliberation in the knowledge that recording will be held securely. Chris Merret will be removed from the call so he can not record the conversation."

Chris Merrett will remove himself from the call and we will count the jury members to make sure he is gone.

The Jury is to decide two things. The question of innocence or guilt. The question of the amount of the remedy instruction that is to be paid by Chris Merrett to Peter-Andrew: Nolan© should the verdict be guilty.

6. When the Jury returns Chris Merrett will be texted or emailed to hear his verdict as is his wish. He can come back in to the meeting.

The Secretary will say:

"To the foreman of the Jury. Have you reached a verdict?"

If the answer is Yes then the secretary will say:

"And what is your verdict?"

If Not Guilty the secretary will say:

"To the foreman of the Jury and all Jury Members. We thank you for your service here today.

You are now dismissed from your jury privilege and you can leave the call at your leisure."

If Guilty then the secretary will say

"And what remedy instruction has the jury agreed on?"

The Jury Foreman is to name the Remedy that has been decided on.

7. The Secretary will then say:

“Chris Merrett. You have been found guilty of the crime of which you have been accused by a jury of your peers. Your peers have seen fit to agree on the remedy amount of ???????.

You now have a choice. You may give your word that you will pay this remedy amount on an installment basis acceptable to your victim. Or, you may refuse to agree to pay this remedy and accept the ruling of outlawry. As an outlaw you will not have the protection of the law. Anyone who helps you can and will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

What is your choice Chris Merrett?”

There may be discussion by Chris Merrett as to how he is going to pay the bill.

Should Chris Merrett indicate he is going to defy the decision of the jury of his peers then the Secretary will say this:

“Chris Merret. You have freely chosen to defy the decision of a jury of your peers. Because you take the position that your victim is not entitled to the protection of the law you shall have the protection of the law withdrawn from you via a writ of outlawry. We shall gain a signature from each jury member conceding that he agrees that the protection of the law be withdrawn from you.

We shall also gain a signature from each jury member conceding that he agrees that a writ of execution be issued by this court to seize your property by any and all means necessary, including force.

Thank you for you attendance Chris Merrett”

At the closing of proceedings the secretary will say:

“This Jury Trial is now complete. The court is closed.”

8. The Secretary will then secure signatures from all Jury Members as to their decisions as and when each Jury Member can sign the forms.

If Chris Merrett is a no show for the day then the portions of the jury trial that concern him will be skipped over. The Jury will still consider the evidence presented to them. The Jury must still unanimously find that there is no reasonable doubt that Chris Merrett has been slandering Peter-Andrew: Nolan© for some years.
