And the Court makes further Order directing YouTube LLC to remove within 24 hours of receipt of notification of the making of this Order, the video uploaded by the Respondent onto the website www.youtube.com bearing the URL <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=XTrlud3x1w1> together with all material including the pleadings, correspondence and any other statement referencing these proceedings, including those referring to the legal representatives who acted in this case and the presiding Judge who dealt with the various applications concerning these proceedings.

And the Court grants liberty to the Applicant's solicitors to notify Google Ireland Ltd., Google Inc., Whois Privacy Protection Service Inc., and Host Collective Inc., by E mail of the making of the Orders herein together with Penal Endorsement contained therein.

And the Court grants liberty to the Applicant's solicitors to notify YouTube LLC by Fax transmission of the making of the Orders herein together with Penal Endorsement contained therein.

And the Court grants liberty to Google Ireland Ltd., and Google Inc., YouTube LLC to apply to Court upon 7 days notice for the vacating or varying of the Order herein.

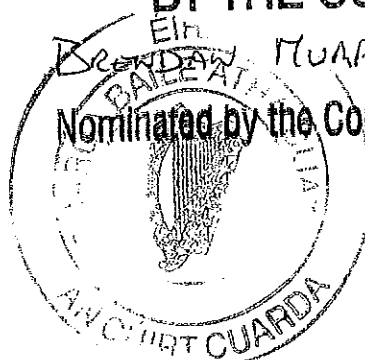
And the Court grants liberty to the Applicant to issue a Notice of Motion for such relief as may be required.
